

2019 Maritime Link Marine Activities

Emera Newfoundland and Labrador (ENL) will be conducting marine activities related to the Maritime Link in the Cabot Strait between late August and the end of October 2019. This work will focus on surveying of the assets and adding additional cable protection where required.

During this period, the MV Horizon Star and the MV Polar King will perform subsea activities and will be visible along the route of the Maritime Link submarine cables.

Scopes to be completed include:

- a submarine cable route survey
- cable burial activity (trenching below the 400m water depth)
- the placement of materials in targeted areas to ensure greater long-term protection of the submarine cables.

Please note: Schedule dates may vary, depending on weather, the work progress and other factors.
