



Notice to the Public

Vegetation Management Program

Emera Newfoundland and Labrador (ENL) advises the public that it will be conducting a Vegetation Management Program along sections of its transmission line rights-of-way between June 21st, 2021 and August 31st, 2021 in the following locations:

- ENL HVAC Transmission Line between Bottom Brook Converter Station and Granite Canal Substation.

ENL's Vegetation Management Program uses a combination of herbicide application and tree cutting to achieve the required level of vegetation control while protecting environmentally sensitive areas. The following herbicides could be used during this program:

- Clearview (PCP# 29752)
- Garlon XRT (PCP# 28945)
- Hasten NT (PCP# 31760)
- Vanquish (PCP# 26980)
- Escort (PCP# 23005)

In accordance with ENL's Environmental Commitments, all vegetation management work will respect buffer zones that have been established for all water courses. This includes lakes, ponds, rivers, wells and other small waterways.
