



**Notice to the Public**  
**Vegetation Management Program**

Emera Newfoundland and Labrador (ENL) advises the public that it will be conducting a Vegetation Management Program along sections of its transmission line rights-of-way between August 3, 2026, and September 30, 2026, pending weather and site conditions in the following locations outside of ENL sites:

- NL HVDC Line - Codroy Pond to Cape Ray –  
Approximately 15% of the route will be treated using a combination of herbicide and cutting. Herbicide use will be limited to small, select areas with incompatible species.
- Grounding Line - various areas from Bottom Brook to Indian Head – cutting as required.

ENL's Vegetation Management Program uses a combination of herbicide application and tree cutting to achieve the required level of vegetation control while protecting environmentally sensitive areas. The following herbicides could be used during this program:

- Arsenal Powerline (PCP# 30203)
- Garlon RTU (PCP #29334)
- Garlon XRT (PCP # 28945)
- Navius Flex (PCP #30922)
- Vision Max (PCP #27736)
- Hasten NT Ultra Spray Adjuvant (PCP #31760)

In accordance with ENL's Environmental Commitments, all vegetation management work will respect buffer zones that have been established for all water courses. This includes lakes, ponds, rivers, wells, and other small waterways.
